**"INTERNATIONAL CULTURE EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR PEACE,  
jointly organized by Shree Hanuman Vyayam Prasarak Mandal (Amravati,  
India) and Embodying Reconciliation (Bogota, Colombia)"**

**5<sup>th</sup> August 2023 To 26 August 2023**

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between HVPM and Embodying Reconciliation Colombia was designed to foster cultural exchange and mutual understanding between India and Colombia. This report provides a comprehensive overview of the events and activities conducted as part of this MoU program, highlighting key moments and achievements.

The program commenced with an opening ceremony on the 5<sup>th</sup> of August 2023. Dignitaries from both HVPM and Embodying Reconciliation Colombia, along with students and faculty members, attended the event. The ceremony included speeches from key representatives, outlining the objectives and expected outcomes of the MoU. The key representative of embodying reconciliation was Ms. Diana Gutierrez, addressed the students to understand the culture of Colombia and to gain the experience of Indian culture

Classes began on the 7<sup>th</sup> of August 2023, focusing on cultural exchanges. The curriculum included cultural studies, and collaborative projects designed to enhance mutual understanding of students towards Colombian culture.

A "Living Picture" event was held on the 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2023, showcasing cultural scenes from India. Participants created tableaux representing significant cultural and historical moments, providing a vivid portrayal of each country's heritage.

The final presentation of the Living Picture event took place on the 18<sup>th</sup> of August. The event was a culmination of the collaborative efforts of students who worked together to create a series of engaging and educational displays. Students participated in a poster-making competition, creating posters based on the theme of India and Colombia's cultural MoU. This activity allowed students to express their creativity and understanding of the cultural ties between the two nations.

The program concluded with a closing ceremony on the 26<sup>th</sup> of August 2023. What they learned in the entire program they demonstrated on the last day of the program. The ceremony featured reflections on the activities conducted, the achievements of the participants, and the overall impact of the MoU program. Certificates to winner of living pictures were distributed to students. The program was ended by presidential speech.
